Data Summary 2004:

There were 50 cases in 2004 versus 46 in 2003



Of these:

- 46% were from natural causes
- 40% by accidental means
- 12% via suicide
- 2% undetermined manner, natural causes
- 36% had autopsies performed versus 64% without
- 35% had toxicology screens only
- 84% were male versus 16% female
- 78% of these cases were still on scene or from a residence
- 29% were in unincorporated county jurisdiction
- 7 Cases were hospice/home health care.
- March was the busiest month in the office's history with 13 deaths.






Death by Gender 2004




Deaths by Gender 2004




Deaths by Location 2004
















Mode of Accidental Deaths 2004






