




# Lower Blue Basin Summit County, Colorado *Environmentally Sensitive Areas Map*

Wetlands delineation data inventory for Summit County, Colorado provided by Whitehorse Associates and USFS. Wetlands data is not survey accurate and is incomplete in some areas. All or part of the irrigated meadows may or may not be jurisdictional wetlands. To determine jurisdictional wetland boundaries, direct field observation/investigation should be conducted.

Slopes were derived from the 10M Digital Elevation Model for the Lower Blue Basin. Grid size is 32,818 feet.
