



Lower Blue Basin Summit County, Colorado *Visibility Map*

- Visible from 10 - 82 points
- Visible from 83 - 155 points
- Visible from 156 - 227 points

Methodology: The observer points were derived using Summit County road centerline data and set every tenth of a mile on I-70, Ryan Gulch Rd, Ute Pass Rd, CR-30 and Highway 9. The observation points were given a 4-foot offset from ground to represent the view from a car or standing. A 10M Digital Elevation Model was used in combination with the Division of Wildlife vegetation layer to develop a terrain model of the Basin. Using the observation points with the terrain model, the areas, which are visible from the observation points, were established. The visible areas are broken into 4 groups of nearly equal intervals to show levels of visibility. Areas that are only visible from 9 or less observation points are also shown on this map.
