

 - "Existing Affordable Workforce Housing and Employee Housing Sites" identify either an individual deed-restricted lot (i.e. single family or duplex lot), or a property that contains one or more deed-restricted affordable workforce or employee housing units (i.e. properties containing deed-restricted townhome or condominium units).
