




Upper Blue Basin Summit County, Colorado Significant Summer Routes Map

Trails that are within town boundaries are not shown unless they are a county trail that crosses town boundaries. Trails in the Breckenridge Ski Area permit boundary are not shown since they are managed by the ski area.

The significant routes shown on this map are not survey accurate, do not necessarily exist as indicated, may not currently be open to public use, and may cross private property without landowner permission. This map should not be interpreted to encourage unauthorized public access.
