SHERIFF JOHN MINOR APPOINTED TO THE PEACE OFFICERS STANDARDS AND TRAINING BOARD

SUMMIT COUNTY, CO- Governor Hickenlooper announced the Boards and Commissions appointments to the Peace Officers Standards and Training Board. Sheriff John Minor has been appointed to the POST Board to serve as an active Sheriff from a county in the State of Colorado.

Sheriff Minor was first appointed to the POST board in 2003 by Governor Owens and was the first sergeant in the State to receive such an appointment. He subsequently resigned that position because he was appointed as Sheriff in early 2004.

The POST Board is made up of professionals and experts within the law and law enforcement communities. The Board makes decisions on policy and advises POST staff on the day-to-day operation of the unit. The POST training board oversees the certification of training programs, training academies and instructors of police officer candidates. The Board also certifies qualified peace officers and revokes officers.

The Board and Staff vision is integrity, ethics, innovation, customer service, focus on mission, honest communication, results orientation, a pledge to excellence, resource responsibility, enlightened and authentic leadership, a future orientation and service to the Colorado community. Sheriff Minor stated, "I am very excited for this opportunity and it is an honor to serve the people of Colorado."
