SHERIFF'S OFFICE ASK FOR PUBLIC'S HELP IN IDENTIFYING SUSPECT(S)

SUMMIT COUNTY, CO- The Summit County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's help in identifying a suspect(s) who allegedly caused the death of a domestic animal. On July 21, 2015 Sheriff's Office deputies were dispatched to a suspicious brown canvas bag that was bound by rope in some bushes near the Snake River inlet on the north shore of Lake Dillon. The body of a black long haired domestic cat was found inside the bag along with two rocks.
