ARREST MADE IN DRUG, JUVENILE SEXUAL ASSAULT CASE

SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO – After nearly a month-long investigation, the Summit County Sheriff's Office has arrested a Dillon man on multiple charges including possession and distribution of methamphetamine and engaging in sexual activity with juveniles.

Brook Randall Fritts, age 31, was taken into custody on April 29 following nearly a month of coordinated investigation between the Summit County Sheriff's Office, Silverthorne Police Department, Dillon Police Department, Summit County Probation, Summit County Social Services and the Fifth Judicial District Attorney's Office.

"I would like to personally thank everyone involved for their cooperation and assistance in piecing these cases together," said Sheriff John Minor. "This truly was a team effort."

Fritts was booked into the Summit County Jail on the following charges: two counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault on a Child, one a Class 4 Felony and one a Class 3 Felony, both of which are subject to indeterminate sentences; Distribution of a Schedule II Controlled Substance, a Class 3 Felony, punishable by 4-12 years in prison and up to \$750,000 fine; two counts of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor and one count of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, Class 4 Felonies which are punishable by 2-6 years in prison and up to \$500,000 fine. Additionally, he was charged with Possession of Narcotic Equipment/Paraphernalia, a Class 2 Petty Offense.

Bond has been set at \$150,000. As in all criminal cases, the defendant is presumed innocent until found guilty in a court of law.

Because of the sensitive nature of this case, no further details will be released at this time.
