SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO- Shortly after 3:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, a Summit County Sheriff's Office Patrol Deputy located an 18 year old male stumbling on Swan Mountain Road East of Sapphire Point. The individual was covered in blood and had sustained obvious facial lacerations. The individual was transported to St. Anthony Summit Medical Center in Frisco and subsequently air lifted to St. Anthony Hospital in Denver due to severe trauma and bodily injury.

During the initial interview, the victim stated he was attacked in the woods by known assailants. Investigators had to wait until after the victim had completed surgery before further information could be discussed.

The victim who resides out of state, remains in St. Anthony Hospital in Denver and is in stable condition. Both the suspect and victim identities are being withheld at this time pending the ongoing investigation. No further information will be provided at this time.
